ICSOBA 2024
Aluminium Dunkerque plant visit
31/10/2024

The Aluminium Dunkerque plant is located approximatively at 750 kms from Lyon. The program includes a return trip to Lyon (with an option for a one-way visit).

Tentative schedule (as of 20/08/2024):

- 7h30 (tbc): departure from Marriott hotel by bus to Lyon Part-Dieu station
- 8h30: departure from Lyon Part-Dieu station (TGV high speed train)
- 11h27: arrival at Lille Europe station
- Travel by bus to Aluminium Dunkerque plant. Lunch in the bus.
- Around 13h15: arrival to the plant. Welcome and safety gears equipment.
- Around 14h00: visit of the 3 main workshops of the plant (carbon, reduction, casthouse). Participants will be split in 3 different smaller groups.
- Around 16h00: safety gears removal, soft drinks
- 16h45 departure to Lille Europe station
- 18h59: departure from Lille Europe (TGV high speed train) – Food tray in the train
- 22h00: arrival at Lyon Part-Dieu station
- Travel by bus to Marriott hotel

This schedule is subject to adjustments. This document will be updated accordingly, and the registered participants notified via Conftool

There are 50 seats possible for this visit allocated on a first serve basis. There will not be any extension of the seat number.

The cost for the trip is 300\$ including train return ticket in first class

An option for a one-way visit is available for participants who would like to catch a plane in Paris CDG, Brussels or London. They will leave the group at Lille Europe train station:

- Paris CDG: Departure 19h01 Arrival 19h54
- Brussel Eurostar: Departure 19h30 Arrival 20h05
- London Eurostar: Departure 19h30 Arrival 19:57 (1h27 – direct)

These are indicative schedule only. Each participant needs to book his/her ticket independently of ICSOBA.

The cost for the trip is 200\$ including train one-way ticket in first class
